- Provide access to and implement various therapies; cognitive, music, art, etc.
- Collect / assess in-depth info about the client function to identify needs and plan specific objectives, goals and actions designed to meet client needs
- Plan specific objectives, goals and actions designed to meet client needs, emphasizing on implementation and intervention, in order to accomplish goals
- Monitor and evaluate plan effectiveness making changes as required while supervising and directing all aspects of a program
- Participate in program client program reviews and conferences
- Produce reports and documentation
